



Internship Guide for Module 9 of the Master's Program Religion, Ethics, and Politics

- The internship can, for example, be with national or international organizations, a political party, a media institution, a relevant advocacy group/NGO, or a religiously oriented institution. An internship must have a minimum duration of eight weeks. It is worth 10ECPs. Your internship must be thematically connected to your course of studies.
- You have to get approval for your internship in advance by the MAREPOL internship supervisor, Prof. Dr. Christoph Schuck. Upon completion it has be registered as passed.

Proceed as follows:

- 1. Please prepare a PDF document containing the following information
 - Title of your internship
 - Link to the official website
 - Address of the internship site as well as the period of your internship
 - Short description of your tasks and duties during the internship
 - → Three guiding questionsm for the internship report

- 2. You will receive approval of your internship via email.
- **3.** During your internship, please ask for a confirmation of your internship in form of an internship certificate. The exact time of your internship hast to be included in the document.
- **4.** Prepare a field report about your internship. The internship report should be ten pages in length. It has to fulfill the following criteria:
 - A cover page with your full name, matriculation number, basic information about your internship
 - → Your three guiding questions (from the approval process) and the answers to them
 - Comprehensibly link your previous guiding questions to your internship by merging scientific findings and practical experiences
- 5. Submit your internship report together with your internship confirmation via e-mail with Prof. Dr. Christoph Schuck (christoph.m.schuck@tu-dortmund.de) and Niklas Dummer (marepol.ht@tu-dortmund.de).
